

What % of Grade 3-5 students reported they were bullied on school property in your district?







How many children were present during domestic violence arrests in 2015?









What % of students in your district reported they felt "so sad or hopeless almost everyday for 2 weeks or more in a row that they stopped doing some usual activities?"








Student Reports of Feeling Sad or Hopeless Everyday for 2 Weeks in Past Year, 2017

What school district had the highest number of absences by teens due to lack of sleep?












Self Reports of Caring Adult Connection at School Among 6th-12th Graders, 2017

Yes (County Total=5207) No (County Total=785) Don't Know (County Total=1511)




Have school suspensions remained constant over the years?
